Thank you for booking with Eaton Vale Scout and Guide Activity Centre.

With the ongoing COVID pandemic we do have certain regulations and requirements that we will need to adhere to. We ask that you therefore take the time to read this, sharing it with members of your Scout/Guide group as relevant.

Please be aware that you must ensure that you have met all the requirements requested by your member organisation prior to your booking. You are responsible for your group at all times.

Car Park:

Owing to Building works onsite our car park is parking at reduced capacity. We therefore ask that you park as considerably as possible.

Your Activity session will begin at 6pm and our activity instructor will meet your group in the grass area at the back of the car park.

We suggest that this is where you arrange to meet your group.

Collection

Your time onsite finishes at 8.15pm and we ask that all members of your party have left by 8.30pm however you are welcome to leave any time prior to then (please advise us if this is the case)

We would again suggest that collect is from the grass area as the back of the car park.

- We would strongly encourage you to ask families to be prompt at arrival and drop off. They will not be able to wait onsite for their young people during the session and owing to the smaller size of the car park we do not have the capacity for them to be hanging around at



collection and drop off. Families collecting members are NOT to come onsite and must await collection of their young people in the car park.

- Leaders who are parking in the car park are advised to park close to each other, either next to the green container by the bins or in front of the dragon.
- You as a group leader are responsible for the safe drop off and collection of your members.

Bathroom facilities:

Where possible you will be allocated a 'side' of the toilet block for the duration of your stay. You as a group leader are responsible for ensuring social distancing measures are adhered to by your group whilst using the facilities. If you have a mixed gender group, then you are responsible for managing this as toilet facilities will not be male and female however each toilet is self-contained. If you are bringing more than one bubble, we cannot guarantee that each bubble will have a separate side and you may be required to have a side of the toilet block as a group.

Toilet will be cleaned before and after your visit.

Free use of site:

During your time with us you will have free use of an area of site for you to provide your own activities. We ask that you remain with your group within your designated area as you may not be only group onsite during this time. You are responsible for following all COVID guidelines during this time.

Weather:

None of our activity areas are undercover and neither is the campsite that you will be provided with after your session.

You will therefore need to ensure that young people dress for the weather. Site even on a lovely sunny day can be wet underfoot and the wind can be strong. Please stress to families the importance of suitable clothing so that young people can make the most out of the session.

If you wish to attend site early to erect a shelter on the campsite, please let us know on booking and we will do our best to facilitate this access for you.

First Aid and illness

You are responsible for the First Aid needs to all members of your group.

Smoking/Dogs

- We are a non-smoking site and ask that all users respect this.
- Unfortunately, we do not allow dogs onsite (except assistance dogs)

COVID-19:

How will we keep you safe?

We have undertaken a full risk assessment of the provision that we are offering. However, in order to keep you safe we need you and your group to ensure that they adhere to appropriate social distancing guidelines and also regularly wash hands.

What if a member of my party gets COVID or has to self-isolate?

Members of your group must not attend the session if:

- they have one or more coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms



- a member of their household (including someone in their support bubble or childcare bubble if they have one) has coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms
- they are required to quarantine having recently visited countries outside the Common Travel Area
- they have had a positive test

What will we do if we are notified of a case in the centre?

If we are notified that a guest that attended the centre has received a positive test result or if self-isolating, we will seek advice from Public Health England and following the guidance we receive.

Cancellations:

We understand that with COVID things can change very rapidly. For any group that is not able to attend due to COVID we will provide a reschedule to a later date.
