Thank you for booking with Eaton Vale Scout and Guide Activity Centre.

Consent:

We ask that all young people complete the consent form that is provided by us in advance. We will collect and ask for these on arrival. No young will be able to participate without a completed consent form. Obtaining this consent is the responsibility of the Birthday Party organiser.

Arrival:

Please arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before the start of your session. Your instructor will meet you by the Dragon in the car park.

Departure:

We ask that groups depart site and the car park promptly at the end of your session time. We would ask that for collection families remain in their cars and that their young person is returned to them. Family members are not able to walk onto site to collect them.

Families:

We appreciate that families may be keen to stay and watch the party, however this can often detract from the enjoyment for the young people. We would encourage only the family of the birthday party child to remain onsite as the responsible adult.

Bathroom facilities:

You may be sharing toilets with other users during your stay. We ask that the responsible adult supervises young people around the bathroom facilities. Bathroom facilities are cleaned regularly.

Marque hire:

During your Birthday Party you will have use of a marquee, if the space is available beforehand you may be able to set up or access this space early, however this is subject to availability. Our Marquees have picnic tables within them, you are welcome to bring tablecloths and decorations to enhance this space if you wish. You are also welcome to bring activities, games, a cake or picnic items to enjoy at this time. We ask that you remain with your group within your designated area.

Weather:

We are able to run the session whatever the weather, however young people will have a much more enjoyable experience if they are dressed for the weather. Even on a dry day site can still be wet and muddy underfoot. So please do ensure all young people come dressed for this. We will not be able to offer access to any indoor space on wet days.

Smoking/Dogs/Alcohol:

- We are a non-smoking site and ask that all users respect this.
- As a centre focused on children and young people, we do not allow alcohol to be consumed on the premises.
- Unfortunately, we do not allow dogs onsite (except assistance dogs)

Behaviour management:

In order to ensure that your young person has the best party that we can provide we do ask that all young people adhere to and follow the instructions for the activity. We ask that the supervising family member supports the instructor in this.

Water Party only:

We recommend that young people turn up to the party in the clothes that they will be going on the water in. We would recommend light layers, a jumper and trainers or water shoes. We would strongly advise that you also bring a complete change of clothes (including shoes and underwear) along with a towel. We are able to provide showers and changing facilities for the end of your session.
