

## Circus Days – Risk Assessment

### *Eaton Vale Scout and Guide Activity Centre Specific*

<b>Hazard</b>	<b>Injury</b>	<b>Risk Control Measures</b>
Slips, trips and falls	Slight to severe injury.	Site to be checked for any potential hazards prior to event and as part of ongoing centre management. Unit leaders to be responsible for young people and manage their behaviour to reduce these risks.
Lost child or lost group.	Slight to severe. Emotional harm as well as physical a potential risk.	Unit leaders to be responsible for their young people for the duration of the event and ensure that regular head counts are undertaken.
Weather	Slight to severe.	The event will run whatever the weather however modifications may need to be made to adapt to these. These will be advised in advance where possible. Unit leaders to advise young people to dress for the weather and ensure that they bring appropriate clothing.
Unexpected response to activity from children.	Slight to severe. Emotional harm, as well as physical, a potential risk.	Unit leaders to ensure that adults are competent and able to manage the needs of the group that they are responsible for.
Intruder on Site	Slight to severe. Emotional harm, as well as physical, a potential risk.	All staff and adults to be vigilant and share any concerns immediately with centre staff.
First Aid related emergencies	Slight to severe injury.	Leaders advised that they are responsible for First aid for duration of event. Centre will ensure that a member of the team is qualified in first aid and can assist as required for duration of the event. Leaders to share any significant medical needs with activity instructors at start of session.

**This risk assessment is in addition to current risk assessments at Eaton Vale Scout and Guide Activity Centre and should be used in conjunction with current activity and site risk assessments.**
